These results highlight the strength of our religious instruction, meaningful celebrations, and strong connection to the local Catholic Church, as well as our commitment to nurturing spiritual growth and fostering a faith-filled community that inspires students and families alike.

Insights

- St. Mary's outperformed the provincial benchmarks in all categories of the assurance survey and highlights the following:
- 95.9% of parents, students, and teachers believe St. Mary's School provides a welcoming, caring, respectful, and safe environment 11.9% above the provincial average. Student survey results were particularly strong at 94.9%, surpassing the provincial average by 19.7%. These results highlight St. Mary's commitment to fostering a faith-filled, inclusive community where students feel valued and supported.
- 91.5% of parents, students, and teachers expressed satisfaction with students modeling active citizenship, 18.1% above the provincial average. This result reflects our dedication as an eco-friendly school and our faith-infused service work. Guided by Catholic Social Teachings, St. Mary's nurtures responsible, compassionate citizens who embody respect, integrity, and service in their daily lives
- 95.3% of St. Mary's Grade 6 students achieved the acceptable standard on the 2024 social studies PAT, 26.8% above the provincial average, with 41.7% reaching the standard of excellence, exceeding the provincial rate by 22.1%. These results reflect our commitment to academic excellence and the effectiveness of our teaching and learning practices.
- 94.7% of teachers, parents, and students expressed satisfaction with the quality of education, with 89.7% student engagement. These results showcase the success of initiatives like Layers of Literacy, hands-on learning, and technology integration in creating dynamic and meaningful student experiences.
- 87.3% of St. Mary's students reported access to appropriate supports and services, exceeding the provincial average by 7.4%. This highlights our commitment to student success through collaboration with families and community partners.
